We loaded onto the bus and made our way through the streets of Athens, amazed at the skill of our driver to maneuver around the crazy traffic and narrow roads.

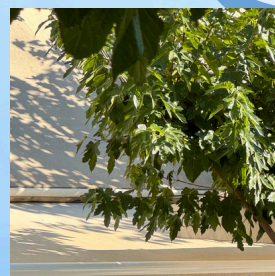
The afternoon provided us time to rest and explore the city on our own.
